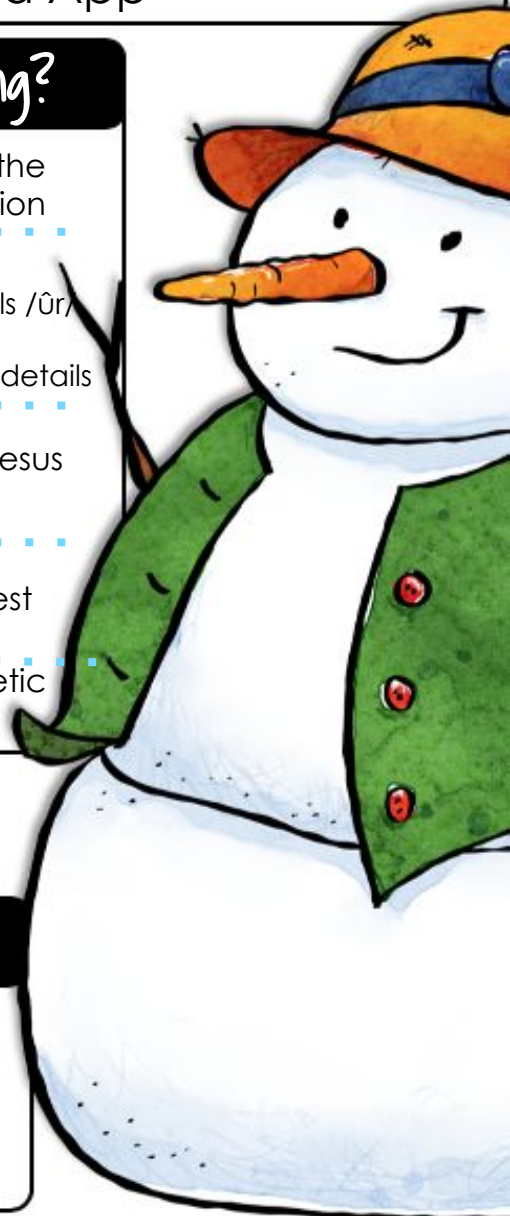
Edmentum
